For our Members who are foodies, this year you will be greeted to a new breakfast buffet area in the Main Lodge dining room. We have taken the little bar located in the main dining room, and are currently renovating it into a new grand buffet area. This new buffet area will have a Chef attended gourmet omelet bar and waffle station, along with all the other items you're

accustom to. The former buffet area will be renovated into additional dining seating for your enjoyment.

We strive to make your culinary experience at the Ranch as great as your hunting experiences are in our fields. We are blessed to have Chef Phil Burrus and the talented crew he has assembled to make this happen daily.

For our Rifle and Pistol shooting family, we are currently building a new 20'x 125" covered range with over twenty shooting benches. At this new facility, by reservation, Members and their guests will be able to shoot a handgun at 10 yards, or a rifle out

to 600 yards, all while being in the shade or out of the weather. Flint Oak Members and dear friends Jim and Sally Bauer are helping making this all possible with their expertise in this field. You will drive by the new Rifle-Pistol range the next time you enter the Ranch on your way to the Lodge.

For our European loving Members. I've save the best news for last in my book. This year we have re-worked one of our oldest Europeans... the Mini European has been remodeled. We have taken this shoot, and have transformed it into a new 14 station layout. Shooters will love the new blind placements, and views of the Ranch. Gunners will test their skills at every other blind, so seven rotations in total for this layout, while they make their way around the circle. The group's half time break will be held after the fourth brace, and please be sure to leave me a warm cookie if you beat me to the fire pit.

If you haven't thought about it yet, I will explain how exciting this new 28-gun, 14 blind European, having seven rotations is going to be. A full base shoot with 28 gunners, two per blind comes with 280 pheasants. The Member always has the option to add extra birds before the event. For this example, let's say the Member adds ten pheasants per gun for his guest, that's...another 280 pheasants, so now we have a grand total of 560 pheasants.

Now pay attention here ladies and gentlemen, you're going to want to get your hats turned around backwards, at least three boxes of shells lined up and ready in your blind for you and your partner, because when I blow the horn to signal for you to load your gun, business is going to "pick up" in a hurry!



New Event and Changes at Flint Oak

This year Flint Oak is excited to announce that we have added a new event to our hunt season. The first annual Flint Oak member/guest is going to be one you won't want to miss. This three day event will take place on October 28th, 29th and 30th and is very limited on the number of attendees. This event is open to all Flint Oak hunt members and are asked to bring one nonmember with them. With just room for twenty members this event

will fill up fast, so sign up early. The member/guest event isn't the only reason to come out to the ranch in October, a lot is going on in the early season, you don't want to miss out on. New hunt season will roll out the first of October and is worth an early visit just to sample to new menu items and drink specials.

Flint Oak has implemented changes this summer to get ready for the hunt season. As we are writing these articles, work is going on to move and expand the buffet area in the dinning room. With the popular addition of The Last Shot Bar, the old bar area gets little use. To best utilize the space we have, the new buffet area will be behind the fireplace and wrap into the dining room. This extra space will allow us to be able to expand our breakfast buffet selections. This renovation will also allow us to add extra seating in the dining room which we so often need.





Have you dreamed of the opportunity of taking a mature Kansas whitetail? Turn that dream into a reality at Flint Oak. We offer single day hunt packages, as well as three day and five day trips that include lodging in our first class Lodge. Hunters all over the country are traveling to Kansas in attempt to harvest a buck, a testament to the quality of giant whitetails in the region.

Over the last three summers, we have implemented a protein feeding program. Several different sites allow deer to access a high protein pellet feed, supplementing health and antler



620-658-4401 www.flintoak.com growth. In addition, we have strategically planted food plots in high density deer areas. With a good mowing, our clover plots are well manicured and looking pristine. We are on the third year with the clover plots and our deer herd has become comfortable in them and are using them aggressively.

As we continue to invest in our whitetail program, only a few deer hunt opportunities remain. By limiting the number of hunters, we can keep unnecessary pressure off our deer herd, not only by harvesting a fewer number of deer, but also by spending less time in the woods scouting, running trail cameras, etc. We want our deer to be contented, and we want a strong quantity of good, quality whitetails.

Flint Oak offers several options for what style of blind or stand you can hunt out of. A numerous amount of tree stands are strategically hung each year for archery hunters, giving ample opportunity to harvest a buck of a lifetime. Our rifle hunters may use them as well, but they also have the option of hunting out of a ground

blind, or one of our tower stands. Fully enclosed with adjustable windows, this is a great option in the heart of winter when the cold wind cuts through. Introducing your kids to the great sport of deer hunting? Keep them out of the elements by hunting out of a tower blind.

Whatever your weapon of choice, we are here to accommodate you and give you the best chance to harvest a mature Kansas whitetail. If you are out of state, look for the Kansas draw application next spring to put your chance in to obtain a Kansas deer tag. The Flint Oak landscape will be sure to impress, and tagging a buck will be a bonus.

Fishing News

We all have hunting on our minds (myself included) but right now is arguably the best fishing of the year. The cooler weather is starting to make the fish more active throughout the day. Not only can we feel fall coming with the cooling temperatures, but the fish know it is coming too. This translates into them putting on the feed bag. All during the fishing season we run fish feeders in all three lakes. On top of that we stock all lakes with shad, bluegill, and tilapia. With this smorgasbord of available bait these fish are chasing like crazy and putting on the pounds. They essentially have their own "Flint Oak Buffet" in the lake.

How does this translate into better fishing? With the wipers and the bass becoming more active they are much more apt to bite any lure you throw. Since they are more active you can put away your slow boring finesse techniques and pick up your fun fast-paced lures like crankbaits, spinnerbaits, chatterbaits, swimbait, rattletraps, and everyone's favorite.... Topwater! This time of year they only have one thing on their mind and that is a high protein diet to bulk up for the winter. Generally, both the bass and the wiper start schooling this time of year. That means if you catch one there is usually several right there with it.

There have been reports of nice bass and wiper being caught out of Center Lake all summer long. I would anticipate this to continue and get better as we go into the fall. This lake is known for its deep clear water with deep grass beds. The bass and wiper can be difficult to catch during the summer when they get out deep and can be buried up in these grass beds. With the water cooling off a lot of the bait fish pull up from the depths and make their way to shallow water and





towards the backs of pockets. When they make this transition the bass and the wiper move right on up with them putting them in a lot easier position to catch. With some vegetation in the lake I would recommend ripping a rattle trap in some of the shallower grass beds. As you work your way up shallower in the more open water a topwater popper will really shine, and as you get around the thicker vegetation a white hollow belly frog and hold on!

Indian Lake has been producing some quality bass all summer long. There has been a good number of fish getting caught per trip. While the tried-and-true swimbait has been a player this summer, a ribbontail worm has been the main staple, fishing it shallow as well as flipping the stand timber with it. It was an extremely dry summer for us bringing the lake down just a couple of feet. The lake being down has allowed some bank grass to grow along the old shoreline. If we get some good fall rain I expect the lake to push up into the grass and make the shallow bite hot and heavy. The wiper

fishing has been tough throughout the summer on Indian Lake, but with fall coming the bit should be picking back up.

West Lake produced some awesome fishing all summer long. With a 17' Bass Tracker with a brand new trolling motor on the front, it has proven to be a great fishing experience. The bass have been biting well, if you can get them out of the heavy vegetation. This lake has some world class wiper in it. With fall right around the corner the big 8-10+ pound wiper will be actively feeding and aggressive. I would recommend throwing a white swimjig along the grass beds, as well as trying a rattle trap ripping it out of the grass. Topwater will also really shine on this lake.

Don't miss out on an awesome opportunity to get in a last minute fishing trip. Typically we cut off the fishing around the first part of October (weather depending). Give us a call and get that last good fishing trip in before it is too late!

Flint Oak's Private and Open Driven Pheasant Shoots

The driven pheasant shoot, reserved for Europe's royalty and aristocracy until the mid-20th Century, has a long and rich history. The shoot begins with the Horns men. The hunting horns blow notifying the shooters to begin and the "beaters", traditionally servants walking through the woods driving the game ahead of them, start pushing the birds towards the shooters. When the birds approach the clearing at the edge of the forest they flush high and fly very, very fast towards the waiting guns providing "missile" like targets. Traditionally, midway through the hunt, servants brought their masters food and drink and a feast at the castle followed the hunt.

Flint Oak's European shoots, in the tradition of those reserved for the kings so long ago, begins with the hunting horns. Flint Oak's rich and diverse background provides a truly exciting pheasant shooting for both the novice and the experienced gun. As the

hunters' horns sound across the landscape, prepare for the most exhilarating pheasant shoot of your life. True to tradition, food and drink are provided halfway through the hunt, a welcome respite to the shooting. The hunters' lunch served at the lodge, rounds out the day.

Start planning today for a truly exciting pheasant shooting in Flint Oak's magnificent surroundings. Feel like a king; come to Flint Oak where you are royalty.

Flint Oak not only offers a variety of Private European Hunt choices, Flint Oak's "Open European Shoot", our "Grand Event", is held virtually throughout the Hunt Season (see schedule page 24). The pageantry of this event, the mix of participants, the weather and a myriad of other factors, make each and every shoot unique.

The Major European

78 Guns

The Major European is the "granddaddy" of our Europeans. It has 39 blinds that surround the oak covered hills and vast rock bluffs. It includes a huge Hunter's breakfast, coffee break around a toasty campfire, a hearty lunch, and an equal share of the day's harvest. This is one of those bucket list items, and the enormous size of this European is enough to put a smile on your face.

The Phoenix

18-36 Guns

The Phoenix was a mythical bird that arose from the smoke and ashes of its own destruction! Thus, we thought it was an appropriate name for this driven shoot because those birds just seem to keep rising and flying despite smoking shotguns! The dense number of oak trees on one side, along with the vast openness of the other, is sure to make it a challenge.

The Mini-European

14-28 Guns

The Mini was the first private European shoot introduced to Flint Oak in 1982. This shoot has proven to be very exciting and even sportier than we first anticipated. Remodeled into a fourteen blind shoot, the Mini will accommodate up to twenty eight shooters. Rotate every other blind with fast flying birds and quick shooting!

The Osage

10-20 Guns

The newest addition to the Flint Oak European lineup, The Osage, is located on the northwest corner of the Ranch. This beautiful area was once home to the Osage Tribe where they lived and hunted buffalo. Many artifacts have been found close to this site as well as many other areas at Flint Oak and are on display in the Lodge entryway. Challenging forested shots keep all participants entertained and smiling.

Advantages of the European Hunt European shoots are a great way to introduce your friends or business clients to Flint Oak. They are designed for Private groups of all sizes. This type of shoot is ideal for those not able to Field Hunt. When you factor in the unpredictability of Kansas weather, even the most experienced shooter will be challenged, while the novice will have an enjoyable experience hunting with friends. The camaraderie and atmosphere of these shoots is a great tool for team building. With all this in mind, why not schedule your European Shoot soon? To increase the fun and add more shooting pleasure, extra birds may be purchased for each of these shoots except the Open European.

The Scottie / Double Scottie

6-8 Guns

The Scottie allows smaller groups to enjoy European style shooting. With the layout of this shoot being much smaller than any of the others, it creates an up close and personal shooting experience.

-OR-

Try the "Double Scottie." It is the most popular Scottie choice by our Members. It is different in the fact that the birds are doubled, the gunners rotate around the circle twice, giving more shooting opportunities and a second chance at mastering the nuances of each blind. The harvest percentage may be higher on the second round. This shoot is ideal for those small groups of friends or clients that you wish to entertain on a more personal basis.

The Mecca

8-16 Guns

Webster defines the Mecca as "a center of activity sought as a goal by people sharing a common interest." We at Flint Oak feel this is true with our Mecca. Sitting among some very large oaks and blackjacks that surround cedars and more oaks in the center, it makes for very fun shooting. This European is arguably one of our Members' favorites.

the name of "Millers Speed Dial" and boy do they all show some tremendous







our loaner eight shot Benelli's during the hunt. Another unique aspect of our hunts is that we use lead shot with no shot size larger than a #6. Since this



Super Quail Hunts

The new Hunt Season is upon us and it is time to clear our minds on a good old-fashioned quail hunt. Remember days passed, moving several coveys in a morning and having the time of your life watching the dogs put on a show? Flint Oak's Super Quail Hunts are a resemblance of those cool, crisp winter mornings shooting these beautiful and swift flying gamebirds.

How do you know which bird to shoot?! Do you shoot into the covey and hope one falls? The answer is "NO." Pre-mount

Summer was VERY busy this year

As fall begins to set in, it's always fun to look back at the spring and summer that just transpired. The social season of 2022 was one of the busiest in memory. The spring kicked off with the Kansas Classic 400, an **NSCA Registered Sporting Clays** shoot held at Flint Oak and STC in Augusta KS. Competitors had Saturday and Sunday to shoot 400 registered targets on four different 100 target courses; two at each club. The winner was determined by their cumulative score over all 400 targets. Xander Winchel of Kansas City took High-Over-All with an impressive 365.

After the Kansas Classic was over, the Shooting Sports Department moved into our summer benefit shoots. These shoots consist of 30-100+ people squaring off on up to 15 stations after shooting warmup games like The Long Rabbit, Knockout,

The Long Teal, and Flurries; all which are set up to raise money for the host charity or club. It is not uncommon for

these groups to raise tens of thousands of dollars during their event.

In July Flint Oak hosted Rainier Firearms Academy for a three day Advanced Carbine Class. This class focused on stretching a carbine and the .223 out beyond normal comfortable ranges, with targets being shot out to 600 yards.

Individual and Corporate Membership By-Laws

Flint Oak offers four kinds of hunt memberships, Individual, Corporate (multiple), Junior or Senior.

INDIVIDUAL (Single designee)

Individual Memberships shall be issued in the name of an individual or in the name of a business or firm. Individual Memberships are assigned to one (1) designated individual and are non-transferable. The designee of an Individual Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

CORPORATE (Multiple designees)

Corporate Memberships shall be issued either in the name of a company or an individual associate of a professional group. A company is understood to be any entity holding a Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN). Such named entity (whether a company or an individual associate) shall be designated as the Owner of the Membership, and the rights and privileges of the Membership are the property of the named Owner. The first Designee appointed by the Owner of the Membership shall be responsible for and billed for all charges incurred by designees and their guests. Corporate Memberships include membership rights and privileges for three (3) designated individuals. The first Designee shall be Flint Oak's contact for billing purposes. All designees must be directly employed by said company or an associate of the same firm as the Owner of the Membership. Designees may be changed at no charge provided the Owner of the Membership notifies Flint Oak in writing of the substitution.

JUNIOR (Single designee)

Junior Memberships, for those between the ages of twenty-one and forty, require current Hunt Member sponsorship, are assigned to one (1) designated individual and are non-transferable. The designee of a Junior Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

SENIOR (Single designee)

Senior Memberships are available to our current members, who have been a member for the previous five years and are 70 years of age or older. Membership is assigned to one (1) designated individual and is non-transferable. The designee of a Senior Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

Dues and Charges

- 1. Membership dues, regardless of Membership type, shall be paid in advance. Hunt Membership dues will establish membership for one year from the date of acceptance.
- 2. All monthly charges will be due the tenth of the month following the month such charges were incurred.
- 3. Members will be responsible for any charges and/or damages incurred by their guests. Guests will have no billing privileges.
- 4. Members will be billed monthly.
- Corporate Membership billings will be to one designated Member, and will not be broken down to individual designee charges.
- Hunt credits and/or services included with the initial membership fee must be used during the months of membership. They do not carry over to another membership year, nor are such unused services subject to refund at the conclusion of the membership. Social Memberships receive no hunt credits.

On a Corporate Membership the first Designee or his assigned should collect and forward any moneys paid in order to keep the account accurate. Flint Oak will consider the corporate membership as one account and cannot credit individuals in that account as well as assign hunt credits to individuals in that account. All monies received will be applied to earliest invoices.

The Corporate Membership rate is extended due to the reduction in bookkeeping on one account rather than three individual accounts.

Flint Oak started being developed and planned in 1978 when the first parcel of ground was purchased. In 1982 when the doors first opened for Hunting, memberships were offered for sale. Many said that it would not work, but the old saying "if you build it, they will come" held true. 

All activities at Flint Oak require ADVANCE RESERVATIONS. We limit the reservations w e accept to the personnel and facilities we have available. Unlike the airlines, WE DO NOT OVERBOOK! If we accept your reservation, we guarantee that we will have everything required for your activities (just like buying a ticket to a ball-game). We are located "deep in the country" and do not have passerby business. Our food orders and personnel schedules are made weekly

and must be based on advance reservations.

Once your reservation is booked, we incur the expense of whatever advance ordering planning are required. So if you fail to come. or cancel after the expense of preparations has been incurred. is fair? what Should all quests be penalized by increased charges to cover these expenses? Most of our guests believe it is fairer to charge a cancellation fee to those who create the increased cost!
