Preserve News

Hunting season is winding down for us here at the ranch. As we start to put away our hunting gear, we start to pull out our fire trucks in preparation for the spring prescribed burning. Every year we burn off more than 4,000 acres in less than two-weeks' time. We always start with burning off our bordering zones then start in towards the middle of the ranch depending on the forecasted wind direction. It takes all hands-on deck to get all the fields burnt before the green growth starts to emerge.

We've leased an exciting new piece of property not far from the main entrance of the ranch. The Preserve Department has spent some time over the last few weeks clearing out trees along the fence lines, roadways, and

field edges. This property is not only going to be excellent deer hunting ground but will hopefully provide some promising turkey hunting ground for the upcoming years. There have been some trophy sized bucks spotted on the property as well as a few turkeys. This new piece of ground has some open brome fields along with some very dense hardwoods with both creek bottom and crop ground surrounding it as well. You'll definitely want to be finding yourself a seat in one of our tree stands on this piece of ground during the upcoming fall.

Recently we have acquired a new piece of equipment from our good friends at Wagner Caterpillar. This backhoe replaced our older front-end loader. We are all looking forward to having this in our arsenal, not only for its lifting power but also for how versatile it is. It will allow us to take on a lot more projects and be able to complete them in house and keep making improvements to the ranch.

Now that summer is upon us and all the deer have shed their antlers it is time for the preserve crew to head to the feeders with flat beds loaded down with protein. As soon as bucks loose their racks they almost immediately start the regrowing process. When

this takes place we want them to start eating the protein as soon as possible to put as much growth on as possible. This is our third full season of feeding protein and have seen some impressive results as well. We will continue to feed the protein up until they shed their velvet. We are excited to watch the bucks grow and to see what we will have for deer that we've been watching over the season as well as some new up and comers.

With social season upon us we have gotten our boats all hauled out to the lakes and ready for fishing. Our GP Trap machines are all tuned up and ready for a full summers of shooting clays as well.




Early Friday morning the Greenwood Stocks 100 Sporting clay event will start and will give the competitors a second

Over the winter we were able to successfully get Flint Oak Jett, a female German shorthair, bred to Flint Oak Cain, a male German shorthair and have three male puppies, which we are

excited to get to working with in our training program.

Over the winter we also purchased a male English pointer out of Texas by the name of Copper. Copper is going to make nice addition to the kennel, especially when the season kicks back off and is still warm out. Since he's from Texas he is acclimated to hunting in extreme heat, as well as being a nice dog to walk behind and shoot the ever so sought after Kansas Ring-necked pheasant. Along with the Jett and Cain puppies we've got six puppies out of last year's Coco litter that we will be working with, making sure that they are primed and ready to hit the preserve this fall.

During the winter months, kennel worker/guide Devyn decided that he was going to do some field trialing with his three year old male English setter by the name of Ziggy and his three year old English pointer named Tripp. They set out to get their and Flint Oak's name out in the bird dog world, luckily enough they were able to get away for four different

trials and racked up some hard earned national points. Currently they both ended the season ranked in the top 200 in the entire country so congratulations to them.

As always, the entire staff at the kennel is going to work diligently over the summer to get the best out of the puppies so that they can become full-fledged members of the prestigious Flint Oak kennel.



Flint Oak Boards & Trains Dogs Year Around



2021 – JUST THE BEGINNING

Flint Oak is now home of the Flint Oak Labrador Retriever Club, a member of the Master National Retriever Club. While the biggest percentage of dogs competing are Labradors other breeds included Chessies, Golden Retrievers, Airedales and a Poodle.

There was a total of three separate test ran with the first one being on May

28, 2021 and it was a great success for all. A total of 112 dogs entered in three different classes, 66 in Master Stake, 26 in Senior Stake and 22 in Junior with a total of 64 dogs receiving a qualifying score.

June 2nd was our second hunt test. Master stake had 66 dogs entered with 32 receiving a qualifying score.



Four new Master titles and five dogs qualified for the 2021 Master Nationals. Jeff's dog, Flint Oak's Downtown Juan More Margarita (Taco) won his Master Hunting title.

Finishing out the first year, the third test began on June 16th which was a double master with 66 dogs entered and 31 qualifying during the first Master. The second one also

had 66 dogs entered and 34 receiving a qualifying score.

Flint Oak will hold at least two test during the Spring/Summer of 2022. It's a wonderful experience watching the dogs with their handlers. Check out the Calendar for the dates and come watch.

Here you will find a 17' Bass Tracker tied up to the dock ready for you and your favorite fishing buddy to hit the water. This lake is only rented out to one group at a time so you will have the entire lake to yourself. This lake is also stocked with largemouth bass and wiper as well. Two fish feeders stay running on this lake throughout the season and it is also stocked with bait fish as well. Here you will find big submergent and emergent

SPRING 2022 FISHING BY TRAVIS

It is finally that time of year we've all been waiting for, time to put away the hunting gear and brush the dust off the fishing gear. Get new some new line spooled up on your favorite rods and reels and head to Flint Oak for your next outdoor fishing adventure. We have three different lakes available for you to come fish, all of which are highly managed and stocked to produce some trophy sized fish. Whether you are an experience angler who wants to do a self-guided trip or if you are a first timer and want to go on a fully guided trip, we have you covered. All three lakes are stocked with largemouth bass and wipers (hybrid between a white and a striped bass). While you can catch other species of fish all three lakes are managed specifically for the bass.

The first lake we have available to you is Indian Lake. Indian Lake is the biggest lake on the ranch at about 100 acres. This is our fully guided lake where we have a marina decked out with four bass boats that stay on the water all throughout the fishing season. You'll find this lake has plenty of shallow water point, rocky banks flooded timber, brush piles and some submergent grass' as well to provide excellent cover for the bass. This lake also has five fish feeders running on it to help supplement the wipers diet. This lake is stocked with a combination of bluegill, shad, and tilapia as well all as a forage fish for the bass and the wipers. You will have the opportunity to go out for three hours with an experience guide that will put you on the fish. This is a great

grass beds that provide excellent cover for all the fish. A member last season was wanting to know where to find a band aid to help protect his thumb from all the bass they were catching. You will also find some trophy sized wiper in this lake as well; reports have shown 8+ pound fish.

The third option we have available is Center Lake. Center Lake is a 19-acre lake, with four beaches available for reservation. We allow bank fishing as well as the option to rent out one of our two-seater boats that comes equipped with a 12-volt trolling motor. On Center Lake you will find deep clear water with big rocky bluffs as well as some deep and shallow water submergent grass beds. This lake is also stocked with bass and wipers and all three-forage fish as well. This lake is a lake that is fun for all ages and is at a much more relaxed pace and can be fished at your leisure.

Don't miss out this fishing season and plan that special fishing trip with a friend or with your family that you've always wanted. No matter which lake you choose (or all three throughout the summer) you will not have a better time than at Flint Oak.

NONRESIDENT DEER PERMITS

APPLICATION PERIOD: April 1 – 29, 2022

For all Out of State Hunt Member to hunt at Flint Oak, you must first apply for and receive a deer permit from Kansas Department of Wildlife Parks & Tourism.

Applicants must apply online, ksoutdoors.com or by phone, **1-800-918-2877**.

All fees will have an internet convenience fee added at time of applying online for a permit or preference point. You will also need to purchase a nonresident hunting license:

\$97.50 (16 and over) \$42.50 (15 and younger)

Bag Limit (1) White-tailed deer – buck, doe or fawn
and (1) White-tailed antlerless deer
 No additional fee required, included with White-tailed deer permit.

The deadline for applying is APRIL 29, 2022.

40 YEARS Flint Oak's Annual Hunter Education

Flint Oak will conduct the 40th annual Hunter Education course on August 13 and 14, 2022 with the help of the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism and our local conservation officer. This course consists of outdoor hands on instruction that allows students to become more involved in the learning process. During these sessions, students will be taught history of firearms, firearms basics, ammunition, basic gun safety, hunter responsibility, ethics, and fair chase, field safety and bow hunting. Included are lessons on conservation and wildlife management, wildlife of Kansas, outdoor emergencies, Kansas hunting regulations and boating safety for hunters. The course will run all day on Saturday and half a day on Sunday. After completing the session work, the students will be given a box of shells if they would like to "PRACTICE" what they have learned at Flint Oak's 5-Star rated Sporting Clay Course on Sunday afternoon.

The age requirement to become certified in hunter education is 11 years of age. The hunter education course may be taken by those under the age of 11, on space available basis, but will



be required to take the course again upon reaching the age of 11. There is no charge for the course and everyone is encouraged to take the course even if not required by law.

Remember, anyone born on or after July 1, 1957 must be certified by an approved course in hunter education before they can hunt in Kansas with the exception of anyone 15 years old and under may hunt without hunter education certification provided that they are under the direct supervision of an adult 18 years old or older who has completed a hunter

education course. A one-time deferral of the Hunter Education requirements may be acquired by individuals 16 and older by purchasing an Apprentice hunting license. Holders of Apprentice hunting licenses must hunt under the supervision of a licensed hunter age 18 or older. Under Kansas Law, Hunter Education Certification issued by any state, Canadian Province and some foreign jurisdictions are also deemed to meet the Hunter Education requirements.

after your passion which is why I switched majors from Computer Science to the WOEM program.







Individual and Corporate Membership By-Laws

Flint Oak offers four kinds of hunt memberships, Individual, Corporate (multiple), Junior or Senior.

INDIVIDUAL (Single designee)

Individual Memberships shall be issued in the name of an individual or in the name of a business or firm. Individual Memberships are assigned to one (1) designated individual and are non-transferable. The designee of an Individual Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

CORPORATE (Multiple designees)

Corporate Memberships shall be issued either in the name of a company or an individual associate of a professional group. A company is understood to be any entity holding a Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN). Such named entity (whether a company or an individual associate) shall be designated as the Owner of the Membership, and the rights and privileges of the Membership are the property of the named Owner. The first Designee appointed by the Owner of the Membership shall be responsible for and billed for all charges incurred by designees and their guests.

Corporate Memberships include membership rights and privileges for three (3) designated individuals. The first Designee shall be Flint Oak's contact for billing purposes. All designees must be directly employed by said company or an associate of the same firm as the Owner of the Membership. Designees may be changed at no charge provided the Owner of the Membership notifies Flint Oak in writing of the substitution.

JUNIOR (Single designee)

Junior Memberships, for those between the ages of twenty-one and forty, require current Hunt Member sponsorship, are assigned to one (1) designated individual and are non-transferable. The designee of a Junior Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

SENIOR (Single designee)

Senior Memberships are available to our current members, who have been a member for the previous five years and are 70 years of age or older. Membership is assigned to one (1) designated individual and is non-transferable. The designee of a Senior Membership will be responsible for any charges incurred by his guests.

Dues and Charges

1. Membership dues, regardless of Membership type, shall be paid in advance. Hunt Membership dues will establish membership for one year from the date of acceptance.
2. All monthly charges will be due the tenth of the month following the month such charges were incurred.
3. Members will be responsible for any charges and/or damages incurred by their guests. Guests will have no billing privileges.
4. Members will be billed monthly. Payments to be made by check or ACH payments (no credit cards.)
5. Corporate Membership billings will be to one designated Member, and will not be broken down to individual designee charges.
6. Hunt credits and/or services included with the initial membership fee must be used during the months of membership. They do not carry over to another membership year, nor are such unused services subject to refund at the conclusion of the membership. Social Memberships receive no hunt credits.

On a Corporate Membership the first Designee or his assigned should collect and forward any moneys paid in order to keep the account accurate. Flint Oak will consider the corporate membership as one account and cannot credit individuals in that account as well as assign hunt credits to individuals in that account. All monies received will be applied to earliest invoices.

The Corporate Membership rate is extended due to the reduction in bookkeeping on one account rather than three individual accounts.

2022 HONOR FLIGHT

4th Annual at Flint Oak September 23rd-24th

Flint Oak is honored to be part of this great event again, helping America's Veterans make the trip to our Nation's Capital.

The Honor Flight Network is a Nationwide, non-profit organization created solely to honor America's Veterans for all their sacrifices. The national network presently has 127 hubs in 41 states, eight of which are hosted by Kansas high schools, of which one is found at Parsons High School with the help of their friends at USD 505 Chetopa-St. Paul. The goal of the program is to send Veterans on an all-expense paid trip to Washington, DC to visit their memorials where they reflect at their memorials. Top priority is given to the senior veterans – World War II survivors, along with those other Veterans who may be terminally ill. Korean and Vietnam Wars Veterans are also represented on Flights.

With each Flight costing around \$40,000, events like these are the funding backbone for Honor Flight. The past three events held at Flint Oak have generated over \$22,000

in funds helping send our Nation's Heroes on all expenses-paid trips.

Of all of the wars in recent memory, it was World War II that truly threatened our very existence

FISHING REMINDERS

Fishing is April 1st through October 31st. Catch and release only for Bass and Wipers. See fishing rules. During these months fishing for overnight guests and Social Members is at Center Lake, Duck Pond, along the creek and Lodge Lake from the silo to the windsock. Indian Lake is not included. During the month of September fishing lakes may be booked as long as no European or Field Hunts are scheduled in the vicinity.

During fishing season Flint Oak rental boats are permitted on Center Lake. No boats are allowed on Lodge Lake or Timber Lake due to the shot fall from Sporting Clays. We are very concerned about contamination of our water by zebra mussels or other invasive species. Under no circumstances will boats not owned by Flint Oak be allowed on any of the lakes or the creek. No waders allowed. Artificial bait only in the lakes, barbless hooks required

All activities at Flint Oak require ADVANCE RESERVATIONS. We limit the reservations we accept to the personnel and facilities we have available. Unlike the airlines, WE DO NOT OVERBOOK! If we accept your reservation, we guarantee that we will have everything required for your activities (just like buying a ticket to a ballgame). We are located “deep in the country” and do not have passer-by business. Our food orders and personnel schedules are made weekly and must be based on advance reservations.

Once your reservation is booked, we incur the expense of whatever advance ordering and planning are required. So if you fail to come, or cancel after the expense of preparations has been incurred, what is fair? Should all guests be penalized by increased charges to cover these expenses? Most of our guests believe it is fairer to charge a cancellation fee to those who create the increased cost!

ROOM CANCELLATIONS

Room (meeting or lodging) reservations made for NON-HUNT/FISHING RELATED activities require a first-day deposit per room for non-members to guarantee reservations.

Rooms may be canceled at NO CHARGE twenty-four (24) hours in advance. Cancellations twenty-four (24) hours or less will be charged the full amount per room per day reserved unless other arrangements have been made in writing by management.
